



As part of our ongoing efforts to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of our food distribution network, FIND Food Bank will be adjusting our direct distribution Community Mobile Markets model during the summer months. Effective June 1, 2025, we will transition to a "Supersite" program format, providing larger distributions with extended service hours in each of the valley's geographic regions (East, West, Central, Hi-Desert, and Mountain Regions). This is a strategic shift, informed by data analysis of our distribution sites over the past year.

FIND's Supersite program model will enable us to serve a greater number of individuals at fewer locations, thereby reducing wait times and streamlining the experience for our community members—which is especially needed during the summer months. This change helps provide essential relief to our hardworking staff and volunteers, particularly during a season when volunteer availability decreases. Additionally, this new model allows us to continue meeting community needs with greater consistency and coordination across our network.

We are excited to launch this new food distribution site format to proactively maximize our impact and better serve those who are food insecure. FIND is committed to continually improving our processes to meet food assistance demands and enhance the engagement experiences of both clients and volunteers throughout the summer and beyond.
